- 1. See LIVESTOCK GENERAL RULES for additional requirements.
- 2. Minimum market lamb weight is 95 lbs., and all market lambs must gain 20 lbs. after initial spring weigh in.
- 3. All sheep must have a scrapie individual identification tag, tattoo, or microchip. Any breeder can obtain the tags or herd numbers for tattooing from the Washington State Department of Agriculture VS Office at 1-866-873-2824.
- 4. Market sheep will be weighed at 7:00 pm Wednesday. At this time a decision must be made as to which lamb will sell, if they weighed in more than one.
- 5. Each exhibitor must give personal hands-on care and supervision for at least 60 days prior to the fair for each sheep they bring.
- 6. Only slick shorn sheep can be washed.
- 7. No unaltered or short scrotum animals accepted.
- 8. Any youth entering a livestock animal at the Fair **MUST** enter and participate in the appropriate showmanship contest. Youth must show their own animal in fitting and showing.
- 9. Market lambs are not allowed to compete in breeding classes.
- 10. Each sheep can only classify as 1 breed. The superintendent reserves the right to adjust the classification of your animal based on breed characteristics.
- 11. All Divisions will be closed 3 minutes after the last gate call.
