1. See LIVESTOCK GENERAL RULES for additional requirements.
2. Minimum market goat weight is 50 lbs. Market Goat weigh-in will be Thursday, 8:30 am
3. All goats must have scrapies individual identification tag, tattoo, or microchip. Any breeder can obtain the tags or herd numbers for tattooing from the Washington State Dept. of Agriculture VS Office at 1-866-873-2824.
4. Each exhibitor will give personal hands-on care and supervision to all animals at least 60 days prior to the Fair, or the life of the animal.
5. No horns allowed, *except* fiber, meat, and novelty breeds.
6. **No BUCKS** will be entered in any goat class.
7. Friday night milk-out for dairy goats no earlier than 6:30pm. All milking does must be milked at this time.
8. Any youth entering a livestock animal at the Fair **MUST** enter and participate in the appropriate showmanship contest. Youth must show their own animal.
9. Each goat only classifies as 1 breed. Superintendents reserve the right to adjust the Classification of your animal based on breed characteristics.
10. All Divisions will be closed 3 minutes after the last gate call.
