3. Divisions 4331 through 4334 classes are open to all 4-H members.
4. Clothing exhibitors will be permitted to enter only those articles made during the year.
5. ALL entries must should pattern guide and envelope and must be shown with the outfit, placed in a plastic zipper bag and pinned to the garment. Rule applies for Fashion Revue and all sewing exhibits.
6. Garments may be worn. MUST BE CLEANED AND PRESSED before entry.
7. Accessories may be sewn from fabric, knit, crochet or woven. Each article should be listed separately on entry form and have an entry tag attached to it.
8. **ONLY** one entry per class.

DIVISION 4321. "Fun With Clothes" CBA ages 5 - 7 - It is recommended to choose from classes 1-10, do two or more items.

DIVISION 4322 "Clothing Capers" CBB ages 8 - 10 - It is recommended to choose from classes 1-20. If 1-10 do two or more items, if classes 11-20 do one or more items.

DIVISION 4323 "Clothes that Click" CBC ages 11 - 13 - If you chose classes 1-10, make 3 or more items, 11-20 do two or more items, if classes 21-30 do one or more items.

DIVISION 4324 "Clothes that Click" CBC ages 14 - 19 - Chose from class 21 and up. Do two or more items from classes 21-30, and one or more is from classes 31-47.
