GENERAL RULES

1. Cats must have current feline distemper shots and a certificate so stating. **Cats must be vaccinated against feline Panleukopenia, rhinotracheitis calici, rabies, and leukemia viruses. BRING PROOF OF VACCINATION on the day of the show. All 4-H animal entry forms must be signed by the member's leader or advisor. Open Youth animal entry forms must be signed by a responsible adult.**
2. Cats must have vet inspection on Wednesday from 3:00pm to 7:00pm. **Please have your vet inspection slip ready for the vet to sign.** Animals will not be stalled without them. Decision of the vet will be final.
3. Cats will check in at the Fairgrounds show area at 10:00am Friday and be caged until show time at 2:00pm. Cats will stay on Fairgrounds until 5:00pm, then taken home.
4. Except during the actual cat show, cats must remain in cages or carrying containers with water, litter box and food. **CATS MUST BE IN AN H-TYPE HARNESS** (no collars).
5. Exhibitors are responsible for the care of their cats while on the fairgrounds. Someone must be on duty at all times while cats are on display.
6. Exhibitors may enter one or more cats, but the cats must be entered in separate classes for conformation.
7. No pregnant or nursing cats
8. All cat cages must have windows large enough that the cat is in full view at all times. No covering allowed draped over cages hiding cats.
9. All youth exhibitors must show in Fitting and Showing, Dept. Q. Fitting and Showing Cat exhibitors shall wear long sleeved button up shirt, blue or black jeans or slacks.
10. All cats entered in the Purebred division must show proof of papers.
11. Top Blue Ribbon Fitting and Showing exhibitor will be eligible to enter the Round Robin Showing Contest.

DRESS CODE:

1. All 4-H members shall be dressed in long sleeved, buttoned down shirt with a collar, to be tucked in and sleeves rolled down, blue or black jeans.
2. Open class exhibitors shall wear long sleeved shirts and blue or black jeans.
3. **Heavy leather boots or shoes are REQUIRED for all exhibitors.**

DIVISION 1541. Primary (for live exhibits): ages up to the completion of 2nd grade, with the following exceptions: Primary cannot show horses or swine. If a Primary is showing a dairy, beef, or sheep must refer to that specific animal department guidelines for age requirements on the animal.

DIVISION 1542. Junior: Completion of grades 3, 4, 5

DIVISION 1543. Intermediate: Completion of grades 6, 7, 8

DIVISION 1544. Senior: Completion of grades 9, 10, 11, 12 (must be under 19 years old as of January 1 of the current year)

DIVISION 1545. Large Animal Round Robin (40 points extra for each qualified participant) Classes 1-7

DIVISION 1546. Small Animal Round Robin (40 points extra for each qualified participant) Classes 8-12

All Divisions will be closed 3 minutes after last gate call.
