1. Members may submit only one entry in each class for which they are eligible. Entries are limited to pictures taken during the current 4-H year.
2. Photo size must be 4"X6" or 5"X7" unless class description permits otherwise.
3. All entries must be attached to poster board, matting. **Foam board or corrugated cardboard will not be accepted.** Margins should be evenly spaced around photo and be a minimum of 1" but not exceed 2 ½ ". Please use dry mount adhesives, photo glue, photo stickers or suitable substitute to attach photos. Poster board covering must cover the back of the photo.
4. Attach a completed WSU label C0890 to bottom of photo. Fill out completely. An incomplete or missing label will result in loss of no more than one (1) ribbon placing at the judge's discretion. Note on bottom of label if SLR, film or digital camera.
5. Digital photos must be printed on photo paper; no copy paper photos will be accepted. **Digital photos are NOT enhanced** unless class description specifically requires.
6. All blue-ribbon photos for Juniors, Intermediates, and Seniors can be sent to State Fair. Check your State Fair Book for requirements.

19. Composition Special Lighting – single print: use of strobe, side, or back lighting, twilight or timed exposure
20. Composition Design Elements – single print: emphasis of line, shape, pattern, texture, special angle or contrast
21. Composition Still Life Close Up – single print

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22. "Before and After: - single print of each, mounted on same board

30. Photojournalism – 2 to 4 prints covering a single newsworthy event, mounted on a 11"X14" poster board; place captions beneath photos
31. Digital Enhancement Darkroom Skills – single print: contrast, color, saturation, sharpen, or other photo enhancement that does not distort subject
32. Digital Enhancement: Photo Restoration – single print of copy of original photo and single print of restored photo mounted on the same board
33. Digital Enhancement: Manipulation/Modification – single print: distortion or change of subject using color, contrast, substitution, cropping and/or other technique
