

4-H CLUB WORK

Department Heads; all 4-H leaders in Pend Oreille County

A responsible adult must be in charge of each group of 4-H members on the fairgrounds at all times, particularly at night. Discipline rules will be adhered to whether in the campgrounds or in the main exhibit area. Premiums will be withheld from members for misconduct (i.e.: as in the Washington 4-H State Fair Rules print out) as judged by the 4-H Leaders' Executive Council.

All awards, except otherwise noted, will be made on a group system according to the judges' placing on quality of exhibits. There will be three groups: blue, red and white ribbons. **Members may exhibit or compete in contests only in projects in which they are enrolled, or those projects open to all members.** Only enrolled 4-H members may exhibit. 4-H members are ages 5 through 19.

Cloverbuds: 5-7 years of age and are included in the Pend Oreille County Fair and Rodeo's Primary exhibitor group of Kindergarten-2nd grade children. Cloverbud 4-H members, and Primary exhibitors are not eligible for competitive events or large animal projects including beef, sheep, swine, horse, dairy, and dairy goat. This ruling for 4-H members was made by the Washington State 4-H Youth Program Policy - EM 0758. Pend Oreille County 4-H allows Primary members to enter exhibits in the fair for display only. Exhibits will receive green participation ribbons and participation points will be paid equal to the regular red ribbon awards.

Mark age and grade on hang tag. Add "Mountain West Bank" Award where appropriate. All 4-H animal entry forms must be signed by the member's leader or advisor and mailed by July 15th to Pend Oreille County Fair, Joyce Montgomery, 413951 Highway 20, Cusick, WA 99119.

NOTE: 4-H Livestock and Horse exhibitors refer to ownership rules at the head of each department. No late entries will be accepted. Name of the club to which member belongs must be written on the entry blank. Over-all showmanship in Beef, Dairy, Horses, Swine, Sheep, Goats, Rabbits, Chickens, Dogs, and Cats will be selected from the top over-all showman in each division. Trophies will be given only to members enrolled in respective projects. **All champion and trophy winners MUST be in the Parade of Champions on Sunday unless excused by the Superintendent.**
